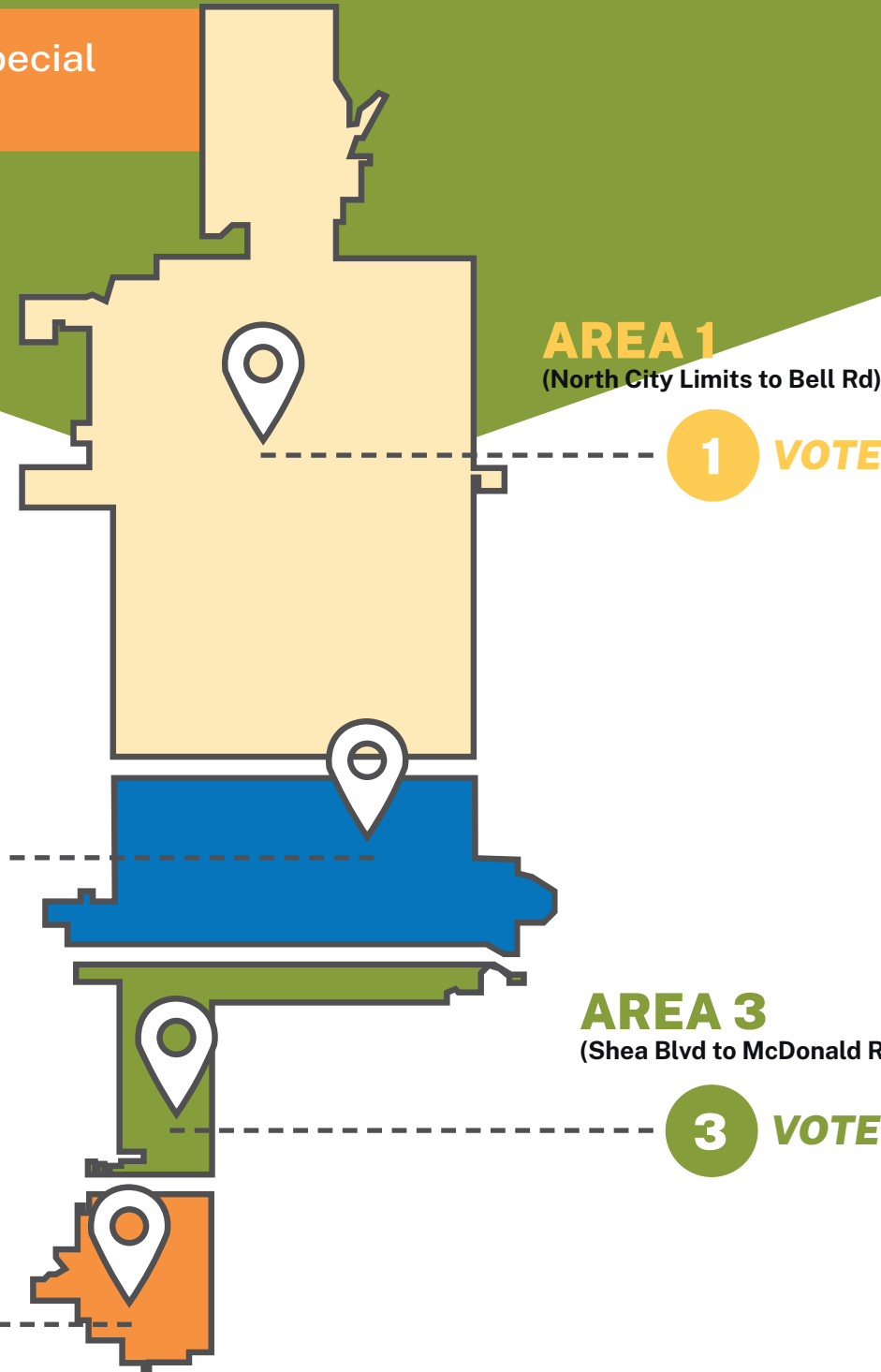


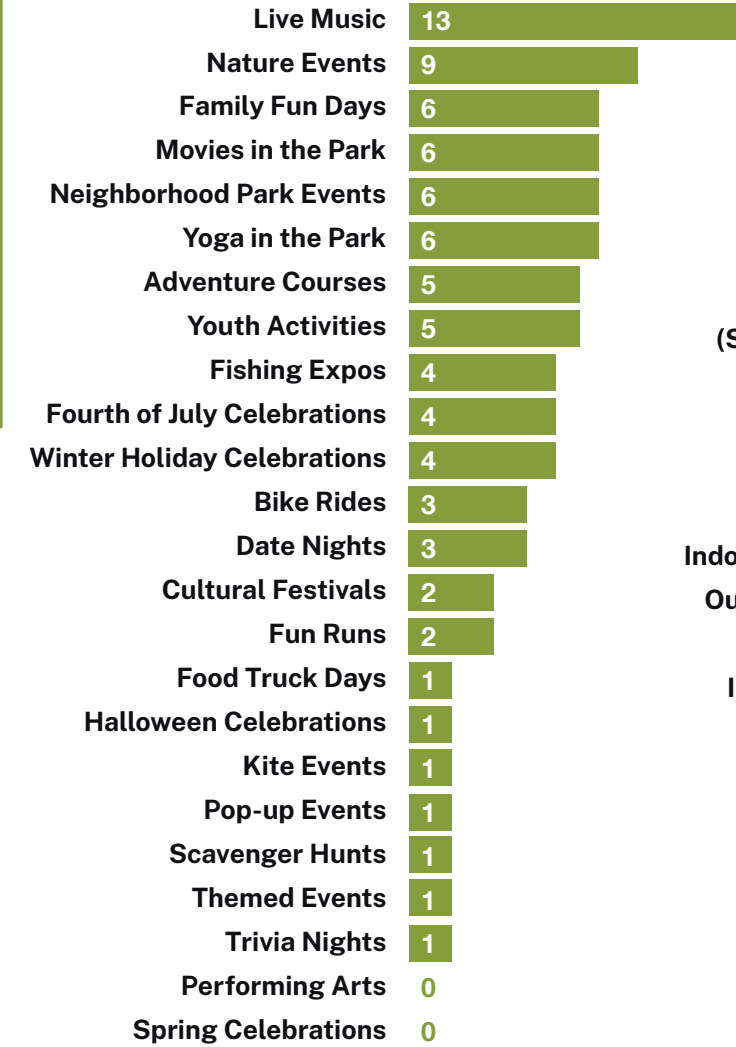

Where Would You Like Special Events to Take Place?



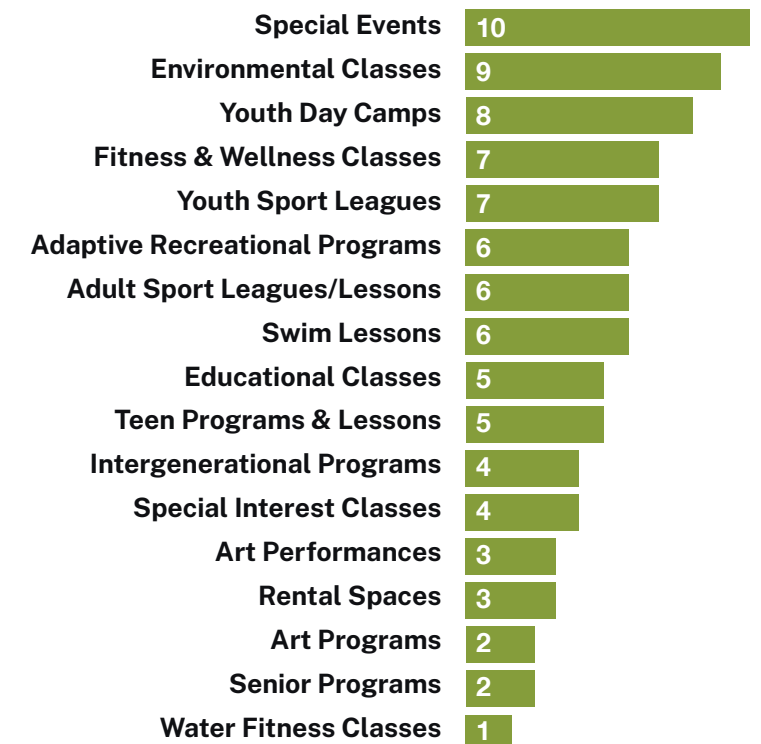

# Summary Scottsdale PRMP Workshop 1

## Comments



- Modern rec/multigenerational center along greenbelt
- More community events at Mountain View Park like the Railroad Park
- Destination Park Playground like Gilbert Regional or Mesa Riverview
- Remodel Chesnutt Park house to expand usable space for neighborhood
- Rec Center to service McCormick. Pool, pickleball, event space, gym carts, camps, etc.
- Splash pad to service McCormick Ranch
- Utilize open space for events, music, etc.
- More programming at the building by Mountain View Park
- Desert gardening education, food & plants & trees
- Senior, adult multigenerational outdoor gatherings-yoga, drum circles, walking groups
- Community co-op (sharing of skills or tools)
- Please get rid of the grass that isn't being used to save water
- Native trees and vegetation
- Protect the mature trees!
- Pollinator garden
- Nature play spaces (land contours, plants, tunnels, no playground equipment)
- Pathways, pathways, pathways! Connectivity!

- Keep gate closed please at Chaparral Park (Jackrabbit to Hayden)
- Pickleball courts, outdoor and indoor
- Shade (natural and built) along trails
- Recreation center attached to greenbelt
- Connection bridge/passage to lake west of Hayden
- Add more ceramics studios with kilns
- Underpass/overpass to connect Camelback to Chaparral Park w/o crossing traffic
- Convert wasted grass spaces like space behind Chaparral pool
- Expand Eldorado pool to accommodate more swim lessons
- Need connectivity between parks via MUPs
- More native plants, trees, and habitats in parks and greenbelt
- More diversity/xeriscape landscape in parks
- Xeriscape areas, less grass
- Community center should be free to residents, especially for kids programs like Cub Scouts
